Analysis Engine for Large-scale Simulation and Big Data

In the past decade society has undergone a digital shift, in which many economic fields have come to depend more on digital techniques, such as AI, big data, simulation, etc. In this talk, we present analytic and simulation technologies which accelerate innovation and digitalization in various industries. We have developed an Analysis Engine, which will allow to process big data and conduct large-scale simulation using super computing architectures.
